What a wonderful 2019 year for the Rappahannock Foundation for the Arts, thanks to you! The RFA fulfilled its mission to be a community arts advocate and to provide exceptional performing arts experiences. This annual report will demonstrate how RFA operations and programs were funded in our fiscal year ending June 30, 2019.

In the 2018-19 season, we brought performing arts to the schools, showcasing theater productions. Six shows were presented to Lancaster Primary and Middle Schools and Chesapeake Academy. The children experienced dramatic performances of classic literature and were thrilled with the actors.

On Stage celebrated its 25th Silver Anniversary, and our theater was brimming with sold out performances. We were fortunate to have an increase of over 100 subscribers, inspired by the bonus thank you concert featuring Judy Collins. RFA Silver Benefactors contributed over \$40,000 to help with the additional expenses, and the production was truly awe-inspiring. Our season was spectacular!

We are very thankful for the generosity of our business partners, sponsors, grantors and donors, whose support comprises about half of our funding. Your financial assistance helps with increasing performance expenditures including updated electronics and artists' fees. 
