Rappahannock Foundation for the Art's On Stage 2019-2020 season of five scheduled shows was brought to a halt when the COVID pandemic shut down the world in March 2020. Subsequently, despite numerous cancellations, postponement and rescheduling challenges, artists and arts organizations were able to host live performances again in 2021. As such, RFA presented to our loyal audience, an unprecedented 9 shows from the combined 2020-2021/2021-2022 seasons by talented artists who were anxious to share their craft again.

Although schools were closed to in-class sessions, Lancaster Primary and Middle School students were able to see five shows. The different artists recorded their shows, supplied the recordings to the school, which were then available to the students for virtual viewing. One show was sent to be viewed by the middle school students at Chesapeake Academy. What the students missed when seeing shows virtually, was the interaction with the actors during then post-show question and answer period.

But, despite all the challenges that were faced and then overcome, RFA is proud that shows went on!!
